Data Review Work Sheet



Purpose: The purpose of this form is to guide teachers & grade level teams on reviewing BIMAS data & action planning to support all students.

Step 1 a. Review Data. Consider the areas of greatest strength & concern on your BIMAS data scales (by school or grade level).

- Behavioral Concern Scales: Check the scale that has the lowest percentage of students in the green (low risk)
 - □ Conduct- *Externalizing* concerns such as anger management, bullying, substance abuse, deviance.
 - Negative Affect- *Internalizing* concerns such as anxiety, depression, withdrawal.
 - Cognitive/Attention- Concerns around attention, focus, organization, planning & memory.
- Adaptive Scales Check the scale that has the lowest percentage of students in the green & blue (typical & strength combined)
 - □ Social- Maintaining friendships, communication skills.
 - Academic Functioning- Academic performance, attendance, following directions.

Step 1 b. Review Data. For each scale checked above record other relevant information (review by grade level, class, student groups, items frequently endorsed, etc.). Record observations below.

Step 2 a. Define the Problem. For the area(s) of concern that you selected, describe what that looks like in your school/grade/classroom. Give current baseline levels

Example: Students inability to successfully solve conflicts with peers results in more conduct concerns in our classroom, making it hard to get to learning. Current UA indicates that 35% of students are in the red level on the social scale.
